Score NoN CS @ 4-1/4"

Run one piece of VV CS through big shot using emboss-resist Technique (see below)

Stamp BBQ Dude in Night of Navy onto smooth part left behind from emboss resist technique

Use Blender Pens to shade in desired Navy Areas and then use pen to pick up Pumpkin ink and color in apron & hat

Stamp "King of the Grill" in Pumpkin on small VV CS; Punch out with Large Oval punch

Punch Scallop Oval in Night of Navy; Layer under "King of the Grill" sentiment piece

On remaining VV CS, Stamp "Happy Father's Day" in Navy and 1 star in each corner in Pumpkin (from Itty Bitty Set)

Center and Adhere Happy Fathers Day piece inside of Card

Mat the embossed piece onto Pumpkin Pie CS and adhere to front of card

Adhere DSP piece over bottom half and center "King" sentiment over top using stampin dimensionals

*Emboss Resist Technique:

Take a 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece of sturdy chipboard

Die-cut desired shape out of chipboard (square used in this example)

Place cardstock into embossing folder

Place chipboard ON TOP of embossing folder (not inside!)

Place both on top of FULL multipurpose platform (no tabs opened)

Place ONE clear cutting pad on top to make "sandwich"

Run through Big Shot
